
PebblePocket

Pebble Pocket enables you to record evidence when you are not able to access your ePAD because

- A computer is not available
- Internet access is not available or limited


Download Pebble Pocket to your smart device

- Access your app store for your device
 - Type Pebble Pocket into your search box
- (nb process shown below is for an apple device)
- Install (or download) and open

- Follow your devices instructions re set up . E.g Language
- You are ready to go





- You now have a view of pebble pocket record sheets, but you need to use the ePAD sheets (West Yorkshire and the Humber ePAD)






- So you need to log in and link to your ePAD – go To account information, it will say you are not logged in




So you need to log in

- Select your institution using the drop down menu



- Then log in using your university emails address and PebblePad password

- Now you are logged in

Settings Tab (bottom left)

Settings – make sure you are set to

- Only send large items by WiFi (this will prevent your phone allowance to be used)
- Send email confirmations (so you know it has been sent)
- Add sent assets to my PebblePad Digest – so they go to your ePAD account
- Prompt before opening Pebble+

Pebble Pad Tab (middle) and My Assets Tab (bottom right)

Pebble Pad Tab

- This tab will take you to your ePAD via your smart device
- NB you must have good internet access

My Assets Tab

- This tab takes you to all the assets you have stored, but not yet sent, to your ePAD. Select the asset you want to send from the list , and send

West Yorkshire and Humber ePAD

- Click on the white rose and 2 types of ePAD forms are available.
 - Experience of hours (for hours log)
 - Record of achievement (for recording evidence towards a practice standard or skill)
- You must use these because it enables your experience and/or hours to be verified. –
- Once completed and verified **SAVE to device**

West Yorkshire and Humber ePAD

- To download to your ePAD, wait until you have a good internet connection
 - Open the app, Go to your asset box (usually the bottom of the page) which will show you have 1 asset)
 - Open, click on the asset and press send
 - The forms now appear in your asset store
 - Open your ePAD to link to an attendance sheet or Practice standard
